



Dear Members and Guests

Please be advised that NSW Health contacted Chopstix restaurant on Thursday night 13th August advising that a casual back of house employee who last worked Sunday the 9th of August has since tested positive to CoVID-19. Another back of house employee tested positive a short time later after working side by side with the first back of house employee. This employee also last worked on Sunday 9th August.

These employees did not display any symptoms of CoVID-19 at the time of working nor did they have any direct contact with club staff or patrons. These employees have since been tested after displaying symptoms. All close contacts from the restaurant to these Chopstix employees including the owner of the business have since been contacted personally by NSW Health and all tested Negative.

Management have since been in contact with NSW health and been advised that the club can operate as normal. At 6am on Friday morning 14th August, a deep clean process was completed by a qualified cleaning contractor and Chopstix will reopen on Wednesday 19th August.

Whilst the club is working with and following NSW Health guidelines, there are no further concerns at this time.
